

The 770 house



In 1940 a group of **Lubavitchers**, one of the largest community of Orthodox Jews, emigrated to New York. They bought a Gothic style house which was originally a medical clinic. This house, at 770 Eastern Parkway in Crown Heights, Brooklyn, was destined to the Rabbi *Yoseph Yitzchak Schneerson*, who had escaped the Nazis. After his death it was taken as an inheritance from his son in law *Menachem Mendel Schneerson*, also a rabbi.

The devotion of the rabbi was greatly appreciated by the *Lubavitcher* and in time they considered this house as a sacred place, until the point that they started to duplicate it around the world. Now there are 12 "770" houses around the world. In Canada, Israel, Brazil, Argentina, United States and Australia. The only one in Europe is located in Milan, and the address is via Poerio 35.
